



Alameda County Sheriffs Office Civilian Motorcycle Course

Three courses offered:

Basic: You will learn the elements of proper turning movements and proper emergency braking techniques. This class is challenging and not recommended for beginners.

Intermediate: You will learn to make “Tight” turning movements, emergency turning movements and advanced emergency braking techniques. You will also begin the above techniques on inclines.

Advanced: All the elements from the Basic and Intermediate training, but equal to basic police enforcement riding skills. *Intermediate Riding Certificate required for this class.*

Location: Alameda County Sheriff’s Regional Training Center, 6289 Madigan Road, Dublin, Ca. (Next to Santa Rita Jail)

All classes taught at the Alameda County Sheriff’s Regional Training Center on the same course used to teach police motor officers. Instruction is provided by California P.O.S.T. Certified Police Motorcycle Instructors. Certificates are issued by the Alameda County Sheriffs Office to riders upon the completion of each rider’s course.

Cost: \$150.00 per class

Motorcycle rental is available at \$50.00 per class. The motorcycles are the same Police Kawasaki 1000’s used in the police courses.
