The Air Museum has approximately 50 restored aircraft on display, including the SR-71, B-24, B-52, B-17 and many more. There is a \$10 admission charge. Senior admission is \$8 (60 and over). **The on-site café is no longer open, so this will be a picnic style lunch. First launched in 1931, it was called the "Sutter" and carried general freight between San Francisco & Sacramento in the 1930s & 1940s. It dropped final anchor in 1951, unable to compete with the trucking industry. In 1966 it was converted into a floating restaurant.
